## BACKCOUNTRY ADVISORY

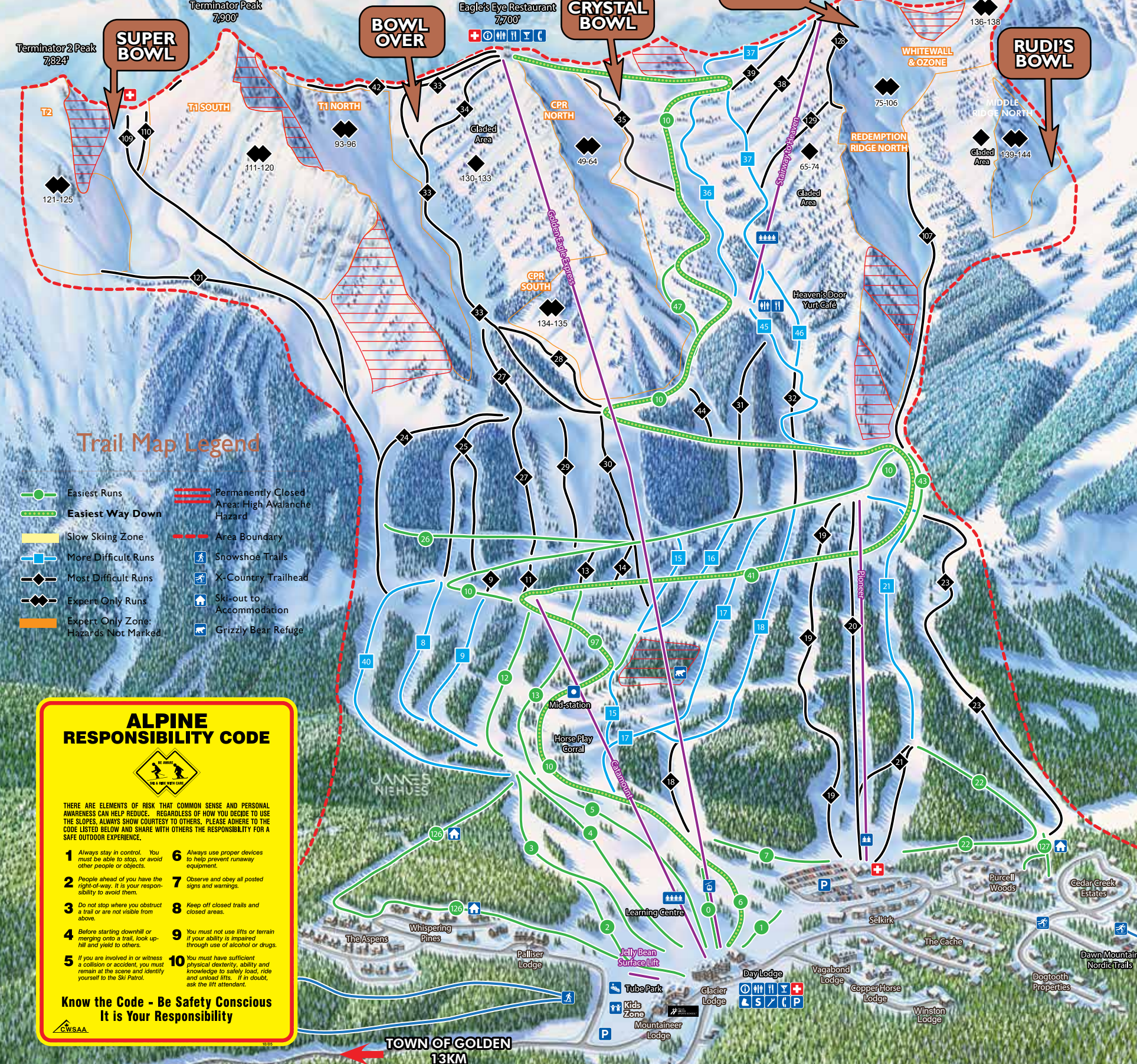
The backcountry outside of Kicking Horse Mountain Resort's operational boundary and controlled recreation area can at times prove to be extremely dangerous and life threatening. Every year multiple involvements with avalanches occur in this area, some resulting in loss of life.

The backcountry outside the resort's posted area boundary is uncontrolled, unmarked, and not patrolled, therefore many unseen hazards and dangers may exist.

Those choosing to leave the ski area boundary do so entirely at their own risk. They should be trained and properly equipped for self rescue as mountain rescue is not available.

Please read the Canadian Avalanche Centre Public Avalanche Bulletin prior to making any decisions to leave the area.

Remember catastrophic avalanches may occur at low, moderate, considerable or high danger levels.



## ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE



THERE ARE ELEMENTS OF RISK THAT COMMON SENSE AND PERSONAL AWARENESS CAN HELP REDUCE. REGARDLESS OF HOW YOU DECIDE TO USE THE SLOPES, ALWAYS SHOW COURTESY TO OTHERS. PLEASE ADHERE TO THE CODE LISTED BELOW AND SHARE WITH OTHERS THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR A SAFE OUTDOOR EXPERIENCE.

- 1 Always stay in control. You must be able to stop, or avoid other people or objects.
- 2 People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- 3 Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- 4 Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look up-hill and yield to others.
- 5 If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.
- 6 Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- 7 Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
- 8 Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
- 9 You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or drugs.
- 10 You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.
